

# Words Their Way

## Homework

Monday: The students will need to sort the words at home by looking at their patterns. Talk specifically about vowel sounds.

Tuesday: Tonight the students will need to look in their reading, reading packet, or newspaper for other words that follow the same patterns. (15 new words)

Wednesday: Blind sort, A parent or adult will read the words and the student will need to place the word in the popper pattern column. If the student misspells the word, give it to them again.

Thursday: Activity Night! Tonight you can pick from the following activities:

*ABC order:* Put all words in Alphabetical order

*Alteration:* put words together that have the same beginning sound

*Silly Sentences:* Write 5 silly sentences using as many of the words as you can.

*Hangman:* Play hangman with 5 or more words

*Rhyming words:* Find words that rhyme with the WTW words and make a list.

*Building words:* Add suffixes like:ly, est, er, ful, ed, s to WTW words

*Antonyms/ Synonyms:* Find as many as you can with the WTW words

\*The students will need to have their baggie of words and their homework with them at school everyday and at home every night. We will be checking homework and reviewing word sorts every morning. The students will be assessed on Fridays by being able to put their weekly words as well as other new words into correct pattern placement.
